1	Valid Passport (all pages with stamps/visas)
2	Language test results — IELTS General or CELPIP (less than 2 years old)
3	French language test results — TEF/TCF (if claiming French points)
4	Proof of Canadian work experience (minimum 1 year skilled work in Canada within last 3 years)
5	Canadian employment records:
	- T4 slips for each year worked
	- Pay stubs (recent 6 months)
	- Employment letter on company letterhead with duties, hours, salary
	- Record of Employment (ROE)
6	Work Permit(s) — current and previous
7	CRA Notice of Assessment (most recent tax year)
8	Educational documents (degrees, diplomas, transcripts)
9	Educational Credential Assessment (ECA) — optional but recommended for CRS points
10	Police Clearance Certificate (PCC) from all countries lived 6+ months since age 18
11	Medical exam results from designated panel physician
12	Digital photos (IRCC specifications — 35mm x 45mm)
13	National Identity Card
14	Proof of funds (if applicable — CEC applicants with valid job offer may be exempt)

Spouse/Common-Law Partner (if accompanying)	
1	Valid Passport
2	Language test results — IELTS/CELPIP (for additional CRS points)
3	ECA report (for additional CRS points)
4	Marriage Certificate / Common-law declaration
5	Proof of relationship — photos, joint accounts, cohabitation proof
6	Police Clearance Certificate

7	Medical exam results
8	Digital photos
