5	Employment documentation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reference letters from all employers (past 5-10 years) - Pay stubs and T4 slips (if Canadian experience) - Employment contracts - Business registration (if self-employed)
6	Proof of connection to the province — job offer, family, previous residence, education
7	Job offer letter from provincial employer (if employer-driven stream)
8	Settlement funds proof (bank statements, investments)
9	Proof of residency in province (if already in Canada)
10	Business plan (if business/entrepreneur stream)
11	Net worth documentation (if business stream)
